Yordan Radichkov Foreign language high school is a general education municipal high school from 8th to 12th grade. Students are at the age of 14 to 19. They enter the school after taking exams in Bulgarian and Maths. All students study intensively English during the 8th grade and continue studying it till 12th grade. From 9th to 12th grade the students choose to study German, French Spanish or Russian as a second foreign language. Biology, Chemistry and Philosophy are taught bilingually in English and Bulgarian.

The town Vidin is located in the north-western part of Bulgaria, on the boundary with Serbia and Romania, on the bank of the Danube river. The school is situated in a semi-urban region that has lost its economic and industrial potential due to political reasons. We have 22 Roma students. 18 students live in the boarding house near the school. So our school is a regional. We offer studying foreign languages to all our students. The school is rated high in our region. The students are highly motivated to study and achieve progress. After finishing school all students continue their education in universities in Bulgaria or abroad. The students of our school work on the NATIONAL Project "Your lesson" held by the Ministry of education. This Project offers extra-curricular activities to all students in different fields of interest – languages, ICT, photography, intercultural communication, sports, music and dances, theatre.
